





Q3 How do you use the countryside around Little Addington? (please select all those that apply)









Q9 Do you have concerns about light pollution in your locality?



Q10 Do you have concerns about noise and/or disturbance from the following? (Please select all those that apply)







Q13 Which of the following should be identified as a Local Green Space? (Please select all the options that apply)









Q17 Do you think that our Neighbourhood Plan should include guidance on the design of new buildings?



Q18 Are you concerned about the declining population?











Q23 Do you agree that the definition of a Settlement Boundary is a good way of managing housing development?



Q24 In the last five years, have any members of your household left the Parish due to a lack of available, suitable housing?



Q25 Are you, or anyone in your household, likely to need a new home within the next five years?



Q26 How many bedrooms would that home need?









Q30 On a scale of 0 to 10, where 0 is not a problem, how concerned are you with speeding traffic through the village?









Q34 Are there any additional services and facilities you would like to see? (Please select all the options that apply)





Q36 Which of the following economic activities would you support in the parish? (Please select all the options that apply)











Q42 Do you require additional business space in the next three years?



Q43 How likely are you to set up a new business within the parish in the next 10 years?



Q44 What type of household do you live in?




